Interdisciplinary environment

Students and faculty from various fields teamed up to confront local issues with a broad perspective.

This program is designed for doctoral students and is based on SDGs and Clinical Environmental Studies. Over the course of one year, faculty and students from various fields work in teams to identify local issues while exploring and proposing solutions to them. The main objective of the program is to develop human resources who can not only study and research in their own specialized fields, but also conduct research and practice in different fields of study and transdisciplinary cooperation.

The program consists of 2 courses on the left, and students who complete them will receive a certificate at the end of the academic year.
